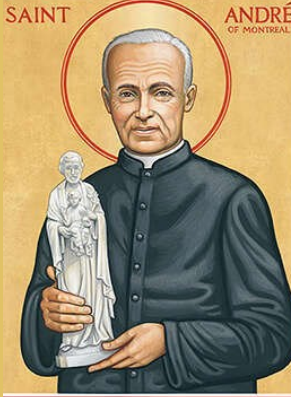

**St. André Bessette,  
Pray for us!**

**Jan 5: St. John Neumann** (1811-1860) He is the first saint I ever venerated in Doylestown, PA, while visiting my aunt and uncle. I knelt at the altar rail, fought back tears, kissed the relic, took a holy card and started fantasizing about priesthood from that day. (I was a sophomore in High School.) But read about **Bd. John Andrew Houben** (1821-1893) as well – a Dutch missionary to Dublin Ireland. God bless both countries now!

**January 6: St. Andrew Corsini** (1302-1373) was a dissipated and vicious young Florentine noble who was converted by the reproaches of his tough-as-nails mom. This Avignon-trained Carmelite was a specialist in reconciling warring factions. His relic shrine is in Florence to this day. **St Charles of Sezze** (1613-1670) a humble

Franciscan friar with breathtaking insight as a spiritual director. I hope to pray at his tomb in Trastevere. **St. André Bessette** (1845-1937) it's hard to believe that our hardy group of pilgrims prayed there in Montréal. He spent 3 years in Rhode Island, but returned to Canada to become a Holy Cross Brother. He spread a devotion to St. Joseph wherever he went and was known for the miraculous healings that followed in his wake.

**January 7: St. Raymund of Peñafort** (1175-1275) this Catalan nobleman bumped into St. Dominic while studying in Bologna and the rest is history. His encyclopedic mind synthesized all canon law. His writings brought about the conversion of so many Jews and Muslims that even St. Thomas Aquinas asked for his help. He died at the age of 99 in Barcelona.

**January 8: St. Lorenzo Giustiniani** (1381-1455) This Venetian Archbishop has the best mystical writings, personal poverty as well as a great portrait done by Bellini. One day in Venice, I'll pray at

his relic shrine.

**January 10: St. Gregory of Nyssa** (330-395) Baby brother of St. Basil, this holy bishop was falsely accused with embezzling Church funds, escaping from jail and living as a fugitive from the law. He hated pilgrimages! (He had a bad experience during one in Jerusalem) However, his theology of the Holy Spirit is unsurpassed.

**January 11: St. Theodosius the Cenobiarch** (423-529) I'll call him the patron saint of longevity (he is well documented to have lived to be 105) He left Cappadocia for Bethlehem and is buried in the cave of the Magi.

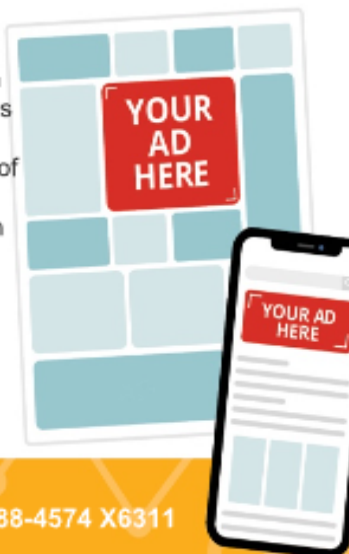

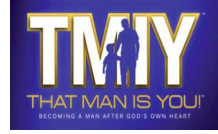
