St. Nick Stenson

December 5: St. Nick

Stenson (1638-1686) went from Danish Lutheran doctor of anatomy to Catholic bishop of Munster. His relic shrine is at the Basilica of San Lorenzo in Florence/ What a conversion story!

December 6: St. Nicholas

(270-343). I invite you to visit the Christian ruins of Myra in Turkey or the shrine relic in Bari in Italy to get a sense of the real St. Nick.

Bd Peter Pascual

(1227-1300) was a bishop imprisoned in Granada for having preached to the Muslims. He was the 6th of his family to be recognized by the Church as canonized martyrs.

December 7: St. Ambrose

(340-397) the man, the legend! Imagine bringing St. Augustine to the baptismal font - and you get the radiant grace of this bishop. I have fervently prayed at his relic's shrine four times already.

Dec 9: St. Juan Diego

(1474 – 1548). I ache at the Indian burial ground where no one thought to mark his grave; Juan Diego was humble to the last. Is it any wonder that our Lady chose him to be the singular vessel of her message to the Americas? I've prayed at his grave site three times.

Dec 11: St. Damasus I

(384) as pope, he saw the end of public worship of pagan gods in Rome as he promoted Christianity as the accepted religion of the empire. But his enduring legacy is his love for venerating saints – he opened the catacombs and placed plaques everywhere to their honor.

St. Daniel the Stylite

(409-493) He is the second most famous pillar-hermit; even barbarian kings would go and kneel before this ascetic who chose to be exposed to the elements as his penitential practice to mortify the flesh for 43 years. He died at the age of 84.

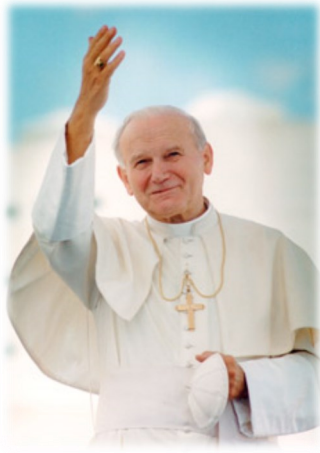
