

### June 12: St. Onuphrius

(400) was an Egyptian desert hermit who wore nothing but a loin-cloth of leaves and a beard that reached to the ground. His story underscores the teaching of the communion of the saints. A church in his honor is right next door to the NAC and the Bambino Gesù.






