June 6: St. Norbert (1080-1134) was a blasé nobleman till he was knocked off his horse in a violent thunderstorm. The conversion was sudden and complete. He sold everything and went to Rome to confess his misdeeds to the pope himself. He founded the Premonstratensians and his relics were preserved from Lutheran Magdeburg by moving them to Catholic Strabov.

June 7: Blessed Anne of St. Bartholomew (1626) St. Teresa of Avila repeatedly talks about her special companion as a great servant of God. Teresa died in Anne's arms. After Teresa's death Anne helped open

convents from Paris to Antwerp. When she died, this sister had 20,000 show up for her funeral: not bad for a cloistered discalced Carmelite nun!

June 9: Bd. Anna Maria Taigi (1769-1837) was a poor servant girl from Siena who, as a married woman with seven children in Rome, had a spiritual life of the highest order. Her poverty, responsibilities, and even spiritual direction with even a cardinal caused quite a stir at the Chigi Palace where she worked. Her body is laid out for veneration at the Church of San Crisogono in Trastevere.

June 11: St. Barnabas (first century) was of a Jewish priestly family from the island of Cyprus who is styled as an apostle because of his travels with St. Paul. At Lystra he was mistaken for the Greek God, Jupiter! He is known to be 'constantly working' yet full of 'joy in the Holy Spirit.'

June 12: St. Onuphrius (400) was an Egyptian desert hermit who wore nothing but a loin-cloth of leaves and a beard that reached to the ground. His story underscores the teaching of the communion of the saints. A church in his honor is right next door to the NAC and the Bambino Gesù.

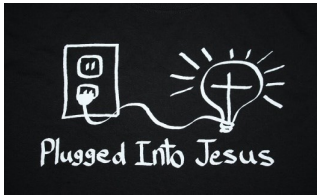
