5th - The Institution of the Eucharist

Sorrowful Mysteries (Tuesdays & Fridays)

1st - The Agony in the Garden

2nd - The Scourging

3rd - The Crowning with Thorns

4th - The Carrying of the Cross

5th - The Crucifixion

Glorious Mysteries (Wednesday & Sundays)

1st - The Resurrection

2nd - The Ascension of the Lord

3rd - The Descent of the Holy Spirit

4th - The Assumption of Our Blessed Mother

5th - The Crowning of Mary as Queen of Heaven

3) **Precepts of the Church** -

1) The Sunday Obligation - You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation, and rest from servile labor.

2) Confession - You shall confess your sins at least once a year.

3) The Easter Duty - You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season.

4) Fasting and Abstinence - You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church (*Fast only on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and to abstain from meat on the Fridays during Lent. On all other Fridays of the year, we may perform some other penance in place of abstinence.*)

5) Supporting the Church - You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church.
